Prescott Memorial Garden



The Prescott Memorial Garden, named after Colonel William Prescott, revolutionary war hero, is a place to remember or honor a loved one or special person. Your donation for one of the following items will not only pay tribute to that person, it will support the camping ministry of Grotonwood in their name.



Bronze Plaques

Each plaque is 24" x 14" and mounted on a perimeter wall or stone face in the garden. Plaques can include pictures and type. Please contact Jennifer Sanborn for pricing.



Bricks

Bricks may be purchased for \$100. Inscriptions can be two lines of 14 characters each and each brick will be placed in the walkway of the garden.



Pavers

Paver stones may be purchased for \$250. Each paver is 12" x 12" and made of marble. Inscriptions can be up to 4 lines of 14 characters each.



Benches

Benches may be purchased for \$1,000. They are made of hardwood with engraved inscriptions. The inscription can be made in a variety of fonts and sizes. Benches are placed along the walkway and around the garden.
